If you would compare online travel agent prices to those offered directly from the hotels, you may find identical costs for some rooms at reputed hotels. Other hotels would match online prices. Some hotels said they had no rooms available as cheap as those online because they had already booked all of the rooms allocated at that price.

Priceline.com allows you to decide what price you want to pay for a hotel room. As always, there is a catch: they pick the hotel, which you pay for sight-unseen with a non-refundable credit card payment.

But if your plans don't call for pin-point location, it's perhaps the best way to save big money on a nice room.

This is often easier said than done, but if you can be flexible with your travel plans it could save you a bundle. When comparing deals, play around with key explore criteria such as dates, location and ratings.

Choose to visit a destination during off-peak periods. With the tourists gone for the season, hotels tend to significantly lower their room rates.

Pay in advance for your hotel reservation. If you can swing this, you'll see some significant savings. We're talking a 4-star hotel in a major city for less than \$90 a nighttime.

Look for special promotions. When you reserve your hotel accommodations, find out if you can take advantage of any special promotions, such as a free breakfast or dinner. Those types of offerings can add value to your hotel stay without increasing the price.
